

On July 16, nearly 180 runners and walkers gathered at The Ingleside Hotel for our second annual Jingle Bell Jog, a 5K run, 2 mile walk and children's fun run. The oldest participant was 83, the youngest just 2. Runners and walkers enjoyed a route along the Lake Country Trail and on the hotel grounds. After crossing the finish line, participants enjoyed food and beverages provided by The Ingleside Hotel, and music by local musician Tony Inzio.
